Best Kept Allotments. It was suggested that Highly Commended certificates awarded in addition to current awards. CJ to look into obtaining designed Allotment mugs for presentation.

GB led discussion about ways to build the community on the allotment. Document produced and agreed by present members. Suggestions include: Using a half plot on Hailey Road as a

communal plot and to have a lock up container/shed to set up a shop to bulk buy resources making them cheaper for allotment holders to purchase. Also to be used for storage of communal equipment. Introduce regular get-togethers on plots following the success of 'Plonk on the plot' at both Hailey Road and Newland. To alternate at the 3 sites.

Site wardens- To look at appointing site wardens on sites.

The role to be keeping a general eye on sites, to maintain paths and to report any issues to committee. It was suggested that allotment holders could make private payment arrangements if they had limited time to manage the areas around their plots, this could also include watering or plot management for holiday cover. Job description to be drawn up and post advertised to all allotment holders and persons on the waiting list.

MK following up obtaining grant funding from Tesco to be used to benefit all sites.
